# INTERNATIONAL SYMPOSIUM BAD REICHENHALL, GERMANY, APRIL 10–11, 2024

We cordially invite you to take part in our "8. Exchange of Experiences of the Measurement Networks + Nano meets Enviro". With this event, we offer European users of GRIMM environmental fine dust measuring devices a platform to share experiences and discuss current measurements. Our service engineer is available to answer any questions you may have in the areas of service and calibration.

The invitation is aimed not only at the managers of official measurement networks or measurement campaigns in research and industry, but also at the measurement technicians who are involved in the calibration, maintenance and service of measurement technology on a daily basis.

The focus of the first day of the event is on the exchange of measuring networks on the measurement of fine dust concentrations outdoors and solutions for ultra-sensitive gas measuring devices on an optical basis. An increasingly important aspect is the challenges posed by the constantly decreasing mass concentration while at the same time increasing demand for high-precision real-time fine dust measuring devices in the sub-10 microgram range.

The ultrafine particles are particularly in focus on the second day of the event, where the results of current measurement campaigns will be presented, the risks of UFPs will be highlighted and experiences with the latest measurement methods will be discussed. Another focus will be on the European Committee for Standardization CEN standards pren 16976 and CEN/TS 17434, which propose a harmonized method for determining the particle number concentration and particle size distribution of UFP in outdoor air.

We look forward to welcoming you in April 2024 for an interesting exchange and an exciting discussion. Please also forward this invitation to interested colleagues.
